2017 WRITERS COMPETITION OFFICIAL RULES

Categories: Fiction and Nonfiction – NO POETRY or RHYMING PROSE

Age Groups: (Birthdate as of Jan. 1) 6-8 Years 9-11 Years 12-14 Years 15-18 Years 19+ Years

Entry Fee: Ages 6-11 - \$1.00 per entry Ages 12 and older - \$2.00 per entry

Deadline: At the library by March 31, 2017.

► RULES MUST BE FOLLOWED OR ENTRY MAY BE DISQUALIFIED ◀

Adults organizing group entries for children: Please make sure you have read and understand the rules.

Entry forms are available at the library, 702 E. Front Ave., Coeur d'Alene, ID 83814-4012, through the library website: /cdalibrary.org/writers/, and by mail by sending a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the library. An entry form and fee must accompany EACH entry.

YOUR RULES CHECKLIST

A participant may submit up to two entries total – two fiction, two nonfiction OR one each in fiction and nonfiction. Each entry must have a signed form and entry fee.

Entries can be up to 2,000 words or less. No entry is too short.

Entries must not have been previously published.

Entries must be typewritten (or printed from a word-processing computer) on 8½ X 11-inch white paper, DOUBLE-SPACED with a 2-inch left margin. Make all other margins 1 inch. Print on one side of page only.

Participants ages 6-8 ONLY may hand-print entries, but writing must be double-spaced and not cursive. Children's illustrations are welcomed within the required margins.

Do not use cursive, all-cap, complicated, or other hard-to-read fonts.

Title page must be included and contain the following information:
Title, your name, category and age group. (Your name should appear ONLY on the title page. Do NOT begin your story on the title page.)

Beginning with the page after the title page, include the title and page numbers on ALL pages in the upper right-hand corner. (Your name should appear ONLY on the title page.) The page after the title page is Page 1. (The title and page number can be within the margin space.)

Do not staple, bind or fold your entry. Please paperclip each copy of the entry.

Each entry must include **one clean copy of the entry**, a signed official entry form, and an entry fee.

Submit in a large, manila envelope (minimum size 9X12) to the library by March 31, 2017. One entry per envelope, please.

Winners will be notified of the time and place of the awards ceremony. Prizes will be given to the winner (or his/her authorized representative) at the ceremony. Prizes will NOT be mailed to winners.

Prizes will be awarded for each category and age group: First Place - \$100; Second Place - \$50; Third Place - \$25

Entries will be judged by professional writers, editors and educators. Winners' names will be provided to local newspapers and will also be listed on the Coeur d'Alene Public Library's website: www.cdalibrary.org and its social media sites. Mailed requests for a winners list should include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

Tips for competitors:

■ Before you begin to write, read the rules that accompany your entry form and then REREAD them. You must use the required format.

■ Try to write the same way you talk. You may find it useful to read your entry out loud. Does it sound natural to you?

■ Write about what you know. Look for stories in the world around you.

■ You will find it valuable to have another person read your story for errors before you submit it.

■ Format, spelling, and grammar are factors in judging. Don't rely entirely on spell check.
